- 3. Testimony is story-telling.
  - Testimony can be personal and it can be communal
  - Testimony can be shared anywhere
  - Testimony is here and now but it's also historical
- 4. Anabaptists suggest that "our life is our witness."
- 5. Two things to keep in mind when we share our testimony/act like witnesses
  - Know who you're talking to and what they need to hear.
  - Be authentic.

#### DISCUSSION

- 1. Why do you think we tend to stress "testimony" as a talking thing vs. a doing thing?

- 3. Read 1 Kings 8:22-61 (or portions thereof). How is King Solomon's prayer like a testimony? How can our prayers be like testimony?
- 4. Read James 2:14-26. What does James say here about the relationship between faith and works (what we say and what we do)?

## **APPLICATION**

- 5. Testimonies fall into two broad categories: positional and progressive. Our positional testimony is our story of coming to faith in Jesus Christ. Our progressive testimony is our story of growing in our faith. Please share one of the other with your group.
- 6. What specific action these days do you think God might be calling you into in support of your testimony?
