DISCUSSION

1. Do you have any hobbies? What do you love to do?
2. How much time and attention do you give your hobby(ies)? How is this like worship? How is this not like worship?
3. If it were up to you, how would order things in worship using Kierkegaard's terms: prompter, actor, and audience)?

BIBLE

4. Read Psalm 95. Like Psalm 100 – it is a call to worship. Identify the verbs in the Psalm that relate to worship. How do these verbs compare with those in Psalm 100? What feelings do these verbs evoke in you? What verbs might you have in a Psalm that you might write as a call to worship?

For what things does the Psalmist give God praise? What do you praise God for?

What warnings does the Psalmist give? How might we interpret them for us?

APPLICATION

5. Take some time this week to write a short (or long) Psalm of your own: that could act as a call to worship specific to you.

6. Commit to do one of the following (as Rob outlined them on Sunday)
 - a. take some time to remember what God has done for me
 - b. take action on something God has asked me to do
 - c. kneel or bow down to pray as an act of reverence and vulnerability

2. What shall we offer up to God?

3. *Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. Know that the Lord is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture. Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations* (Psalm 100).

4. In what sense are our worship leaders and I prompting you to worship?

- Invitation to come
- In the songs we sing
- In prayer
- By opening up the word of God together (1 Cor. 12: 17-28).

5. Worship = submission to another (Heb. = "hishtakhavah" / Greek = "proskuneo").

6. Worship = service to another (Heb. = "abad", "latreuo" – from which we get "liturgy").

7. Worship = remember (Heb. = "zakar").
