#### BIBLE

3. Read and compare Lk. 1:18 (Zechariah's question) and Lk. 1:34 (Mary's question). How are these questions similar and how are they different? Compare the answers given to the questions. How would you explain the difference?

4. Read Lk. 1:41, 67, 80; 2:25, 26, 27. These are all references to the Holy Spirit? Why is this so important? What implications would there be for our faith if we were to deny the virgin birth of Christ?

#### APPLICATION

5. How will you provide a space in your life for God to work in you to do the impossible? What steps will you take?

6. How will you provide for someone else this Christmas: Chilliwack Community Services, Cyrus Centre, Ruth and Naomi's Mission, Salvation Army, Mennonite Central Committee, Child Sponsorship, Mexico Team Member, Reverse 12 Days of Christmas? Other?

## The Call of Christmas

*The Story of Mary: PROVIDE*

Sunday Dec. 4, 2016

1. *In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth...* (Lk. 1:26)
2. *"Can anything good come out of Nazareth?"* (Jn 1:46)
3. God sees us, He knows where we are, and He knows how to get a message to us. Are we prepared to hear from Him?
4. *... the Lord himself will give you a sign: the virgin will conceive and give birth to a son, and will call him Immanuel* (Is. 7:14).
5. *The angel went to her and said, "Greetings, you who are highly favored! The Lord is with you* (Luke 1:28).
6. *Mary was greatly troubled at his words and wondered what kind of greeting this might be. But the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary; you have found favor with God. You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you are to call him Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his father David, and he will reign over Jacob's descendants forever; his kingdom will never end"* (Lk. 1:29-33).
7. The Call of Christmas for Mary was a call to provide for what God had decided. She provided herself, and God would do the rest.
8. *"How will this be," Mary asked the angel, "since I am a virgin?"* (Lk. 1:34)
9. *The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God* (Lk. 1:35).
10. *"The Holy Spirit will come upon Mary, enabling her (as the Spirit always does) to do and be more than she could by herself. But at the same time, the 'power of the Most High' will overshadow her. This is something different: God Himself, the Creator, will surround her completely with his sovereign power."* N.T. Wright
